

### — Definitions



**Benefits fraud** – any intentional dishonest act or omission by a person (whether an individual or corporation) designed to result in receiving benefits they, or another person, are not entitled to

**Abuse/misuse** – using benefits that are excessive or inappropriate for the condition

Fraud is a crime; Abuse/misuse are not.



#### Investigation

#### **Actions - Plan members**

- Removal of electronic claiming privileges
- Reports to employers
- Referral to law enforcement
- Recovery of funds



#### **Actions - Providers**

- Removal of assignment of benefits
- Removal of electronic claim submission access
- Implementation of extra adjudication controls
- Delisting
- Formal complaints to regulatory bodies
- Referral to law enforcement
- Recovery of funds

- Ongoing educational resources and training the 7x times rule
